Delta Independent Science Board meeting

The Delta Independent Science Board (Delta ISB) will meet July 10 regarding its current reviews and efforts. This includes a discussion on the Delta ISB's latest draft report on its review of the adequacy of science to predict and explain the effects of non-native species in Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta ecosystems, and the potential for controlling current and future invaders. Based on this discussion, the Delta ISB may take action on the next steps for the review. The meeting will be webcast and recorded.
