The Delta ISB will moderate a panel discussion on the state of knowledge of food-webs in the Bay-Delta to help orient new members on the topic and to help inform current and future reviews. In addition, the Delta ISB will meet to discuss its latest draft report, "The Science of Nonnative Species in a Dynamic Delta," which was prepared as part of the Delta ISB's responsibility to provide scientific oversight of programs that support adaptive management of the Delta.
