State Water Contractors Welcome Thomas Gibson as Director of the California Department of Water Resources

Sacramento, CA — Today, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Thomas Gibson as Director of the California Department of Water Resources. Mr. Gibson succeeds Karla Nemeth, who has served as Director since her appointment by former Governor Brown in January 2018.

Mr. Gibson brings decades of leadership experience within California’s water industry, most recently serving as a Lead Deputy Director at DWR.

“Mr. Gibson brings the kind of experience and background needed to further the important work already underway at DWR, and the State Water Contractors look forward to working with him to keep building toward a future of greater water reliability for Californians.

“Finally, as we welcome Mr. Gibson, we would like to express our utmost appreciation to the outgoing Director, Karla Nemeth, for nearly two decades of immense work in service of the State Water Project and California’s water resources.”
